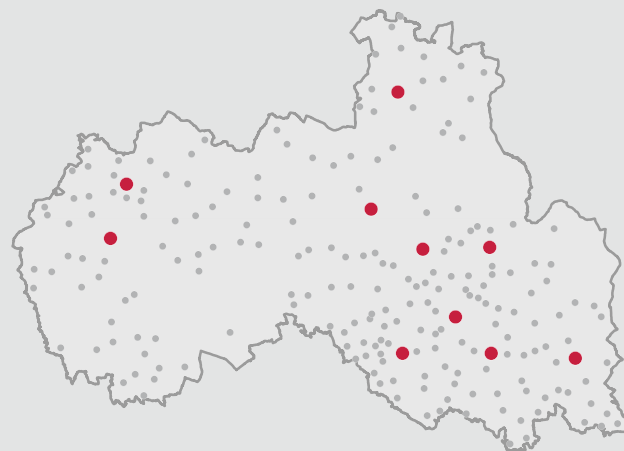

Dear Friends,

How else to introduce a publication that seeks to define and assess the Liberec Region literally from head to toe, or if you prefer, from north to south, than by numbers. Our region which has nearly 440 thousand inhabitants and area of 316 thousand hectares is actually the second smallest in the Czech Republic; in many ways, however, it manages to compensate for this disadvantageous starting point and to actually take a top position. Let me mention tourism here, for example, in regard to which the Liberec Region is able to fully utilise and take advantage of its tremendous potential, and also, in accordance with the average number of overnight stays in comparison with other regions, it occupies second place after the Karlovy Vary Spa Region. Also one of the other positive factors for its future development is the low average age of the population of the region.

And how is the Liberec Region doing in comparison with the entire Czech Republic in regard to such areas as healthcare and transportation? On the following pages you will be able to check this and to not only view the most recent statistical data in regard to the most important and most closely-watched indicators, but there you will also be able to find out, for example, how many mouflon were hunted in our region, what quantity of pears was harvested or how many books were borrowed from libraries.

In this publication we do not only seek to provide a comprehensive overview of the Liberec Region, but we will also be happy if we are able to succeed in managing to break the mindset of the public about the statistics exemplified, for example in terms of the quotation from the British Statesman, Disraeli: "There are three types of lies - lies, damn lies, and statistics.", or as a favourite Czech fairy-tale adage defines it, "statistics are boring, but they do have valuable information and therefore do not lose hope"; the Liberec Region by Numbers will be able to quantify this for us.

THE LOCATION OF THE REGION

The Liberec Region is located in one of the most northern corners of the Czech Republic, adjacent to the border with Germany (the Löbau-Zittau District of the Land of Saxony) and Poland (the Lower Silesian Voivodeship) and with good access to the large industrial and administrative centres (e.g. Prague and Dresden) and with developing connections to the major European transport routes, such as Berlin-Prague-Vienna and Leipzig-Dresden-Wrocław.

Within the Czech Republic the Liberec Region is adjacent in the west to the Ústí nad Labem Region, in the south to the Central Bohemia Region and in the southeast and east to the Hradec Králové Region.

The length of the state borders of the Liberec Region:

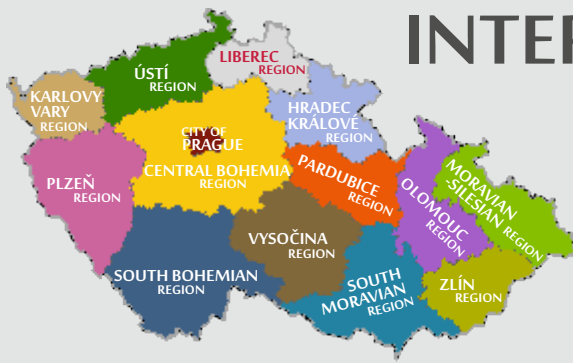
with Germany ... 20 km

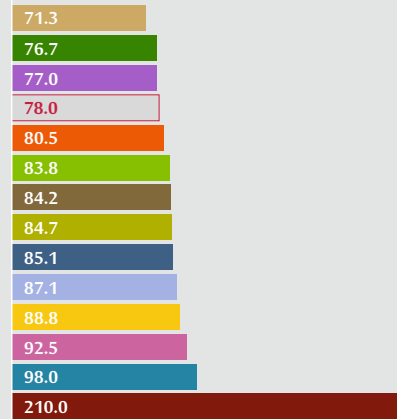
Significant in the region is the proximity of the two largest centres, i.e. Liberec and Jablonec nad Nisou, which together constitute an urban agglomeration.

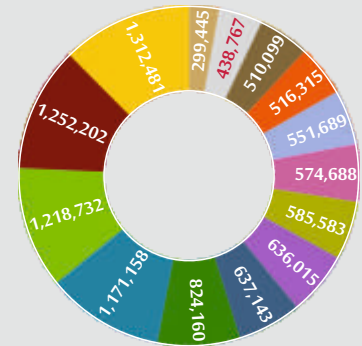
Gross Domestic Product

per capita, CR = 100, year 2013



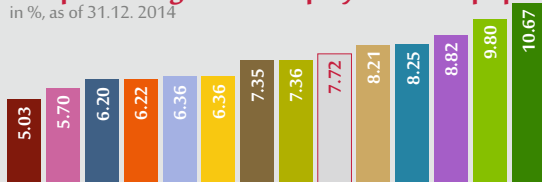
Number of inhabitants

as of 30. 9. 2014



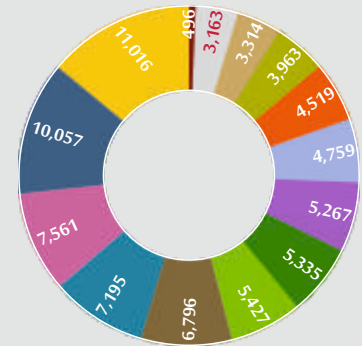
The percentage of unemployed in the population

in km², 2013



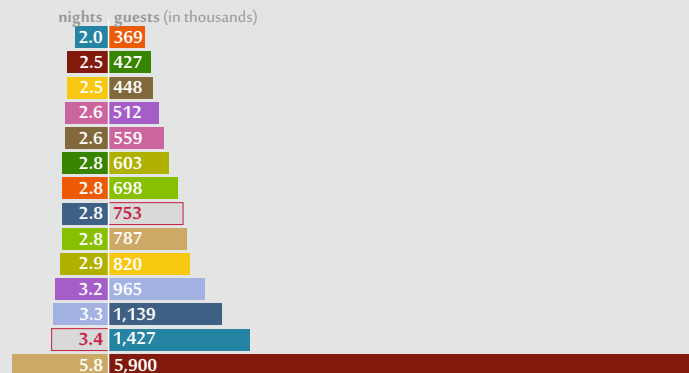

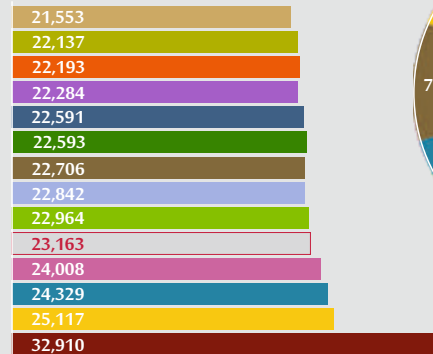
The occupancy of collective accommodation facilities

Average monthly gross wage

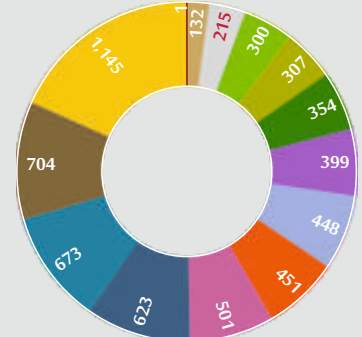

BASIC GEOGRAPHICAL CHARACTERISTICS

The Liberec Region is located in the north of the Czech Republic. Its area includes the northern part of the Czech Basin, the western Giant Mountains with their foothills, the Jizerské Mountains and the eastern area of the Lusatian Mountains.

The entire region is primarily mountainous. Its topography corresponds to its hilly nature.



The water from the region drains into three rivers. The west of the Region comprises the Ploučnice basin, while the east of the region lies in the Upper Elbe basin and the north lies in the Odra (Nisa) basin.

Its rich sources of surface water in its mountainous areas and of groundwater, especially in the North Bohemian Cretaceous Basin, greatly increase the significance of the Liberec Region as a prospective source of both drinking and industrial water and also of mineral springs and deposits of peat (e.g. Kundratice Spa, Libverda Spa). In the entire region there are no larger water bodies of natural origin, while those that have been artificially created include, for example, the recreational Máchovo Lake and the Josefův Důl water reservoir.

The Liberec Region represents a source of important raw materials that are present in the Czech Republic. Within its territory there are deposits of various fuels, ores and industrial and building materials. Trans-regionally there are significant deposits of uranium, glass sand and specific deposits of crushed stone. Regionally, there are also some significant deposits of building materials. Other deposits, based on their quantitative and qualitative parameters, are of only local significance.

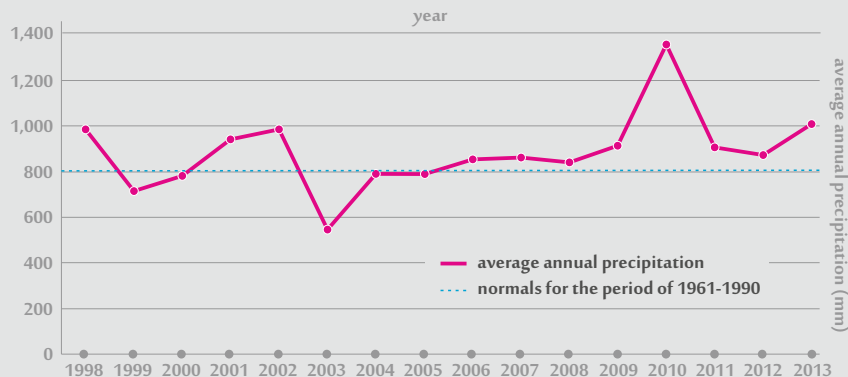
Climatic Conditions

The western and south-western parts have conditions of a slightly warm area.

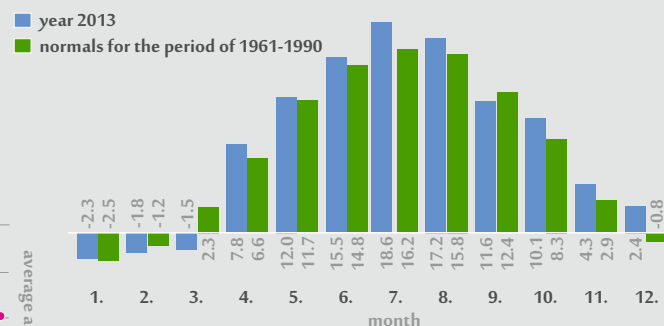
Trends in the average annual precipitation

the meteorological station in Liberec (398 m asl)



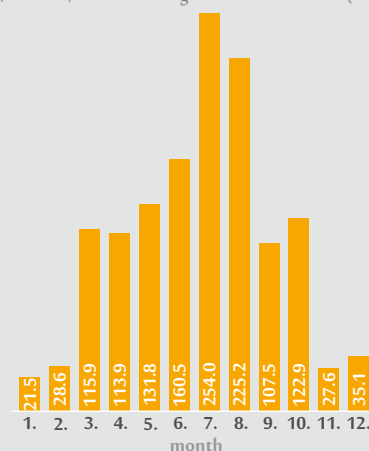
The average air temperature

2013, in hours, the meteorological station in Liberec (398 m asl)



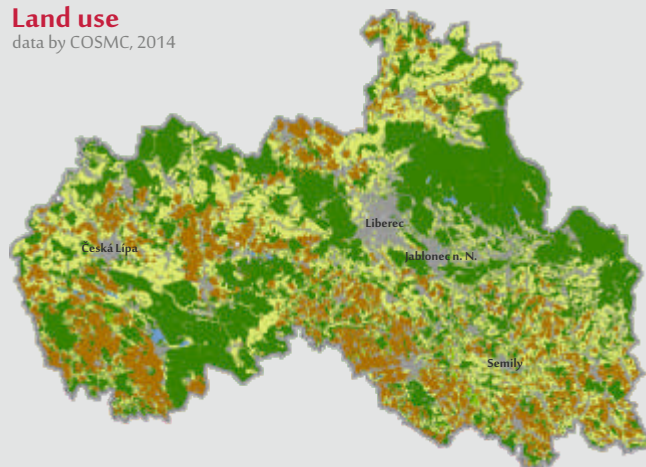

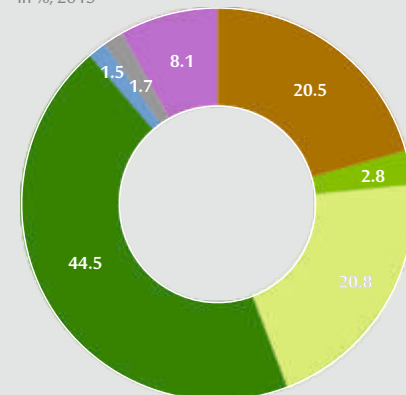

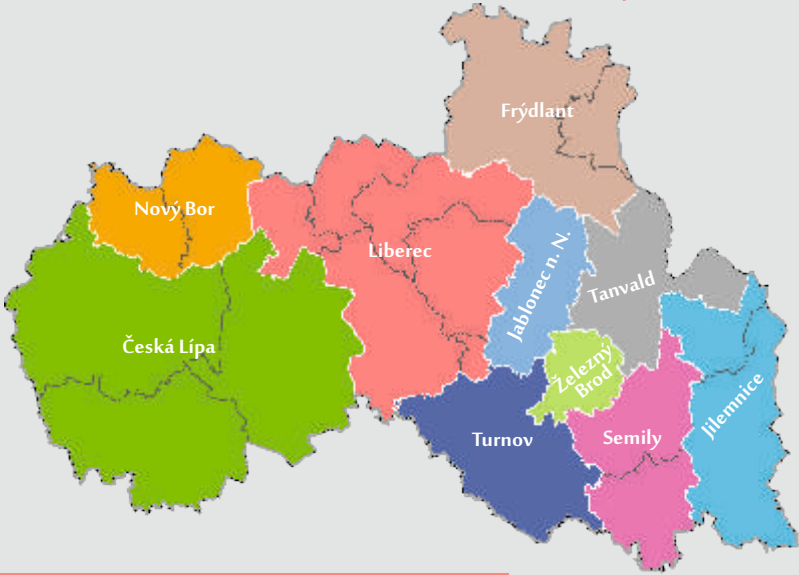

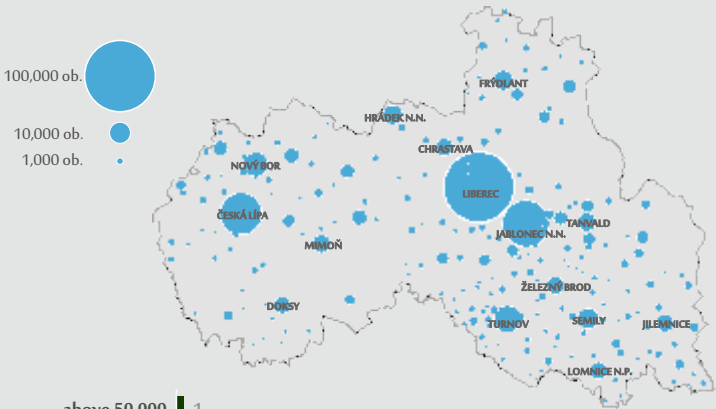

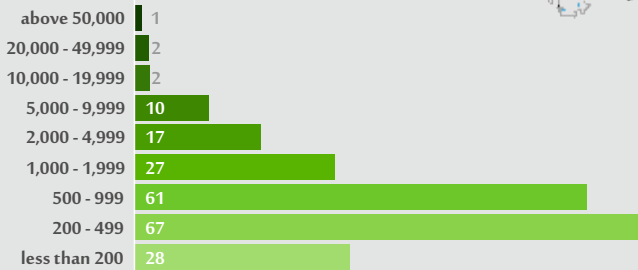
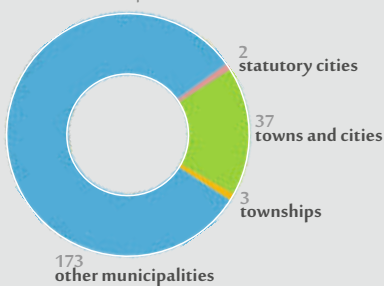
The size structure of municipalities of inhabitants

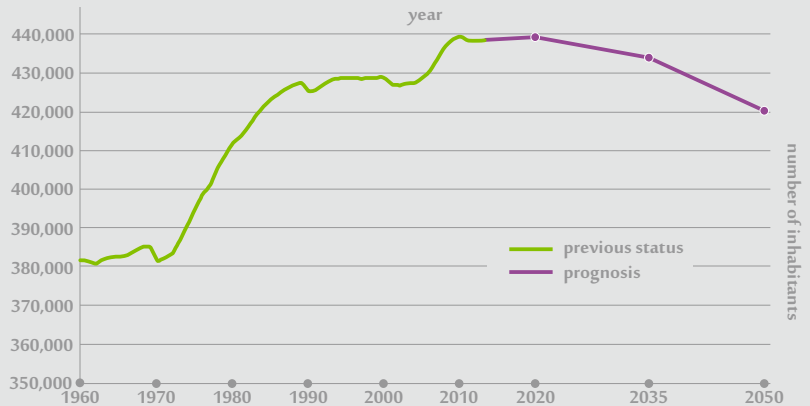

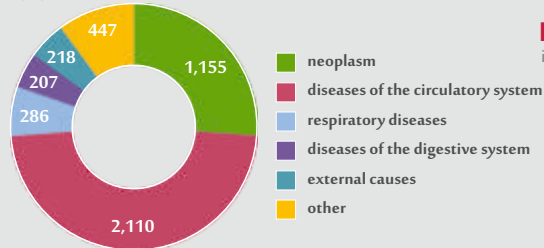

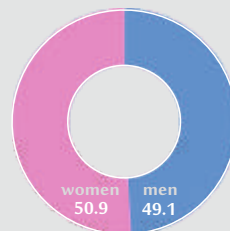

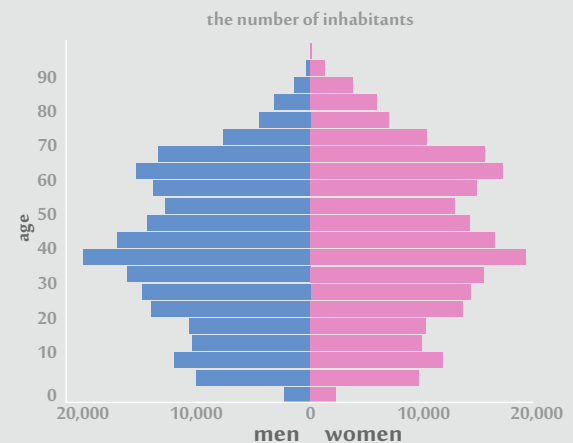
Population by gender

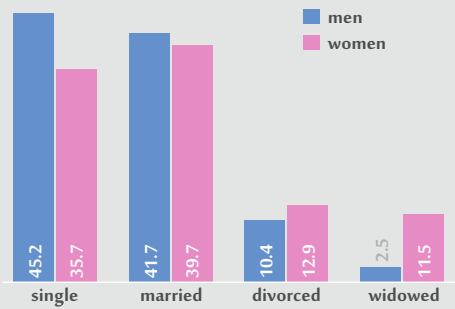

percentage share in the total number of men and women, Census 2011

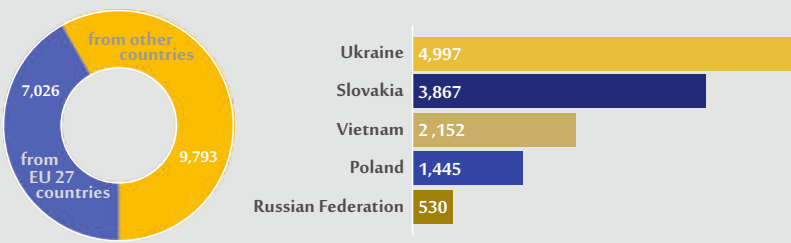

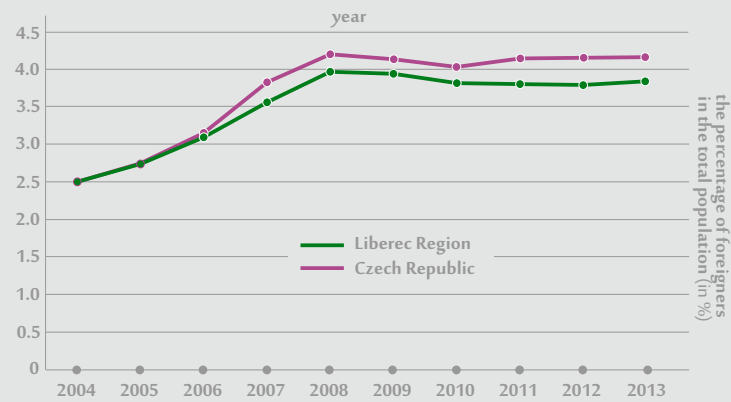

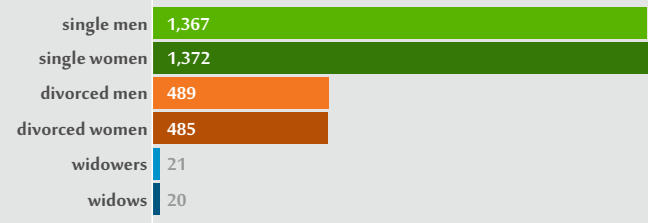


Trend regarding the proportion of foreigners



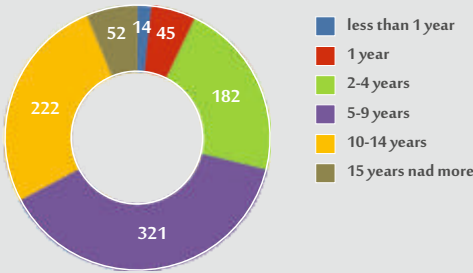
Marriages - marital status of the groom and the bride

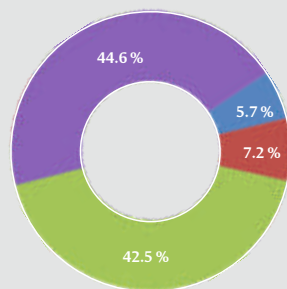
Divorces in accordance with the duration of the marriage

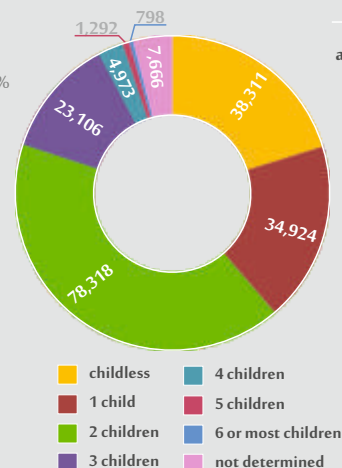

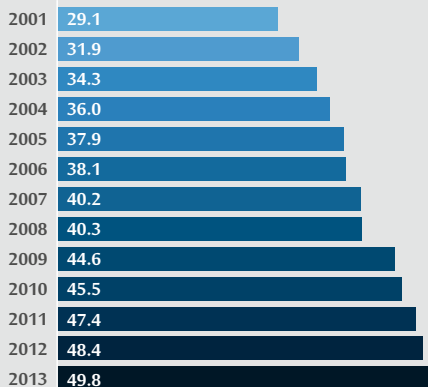
the number of 15+ women by the number of live births, Census 2011

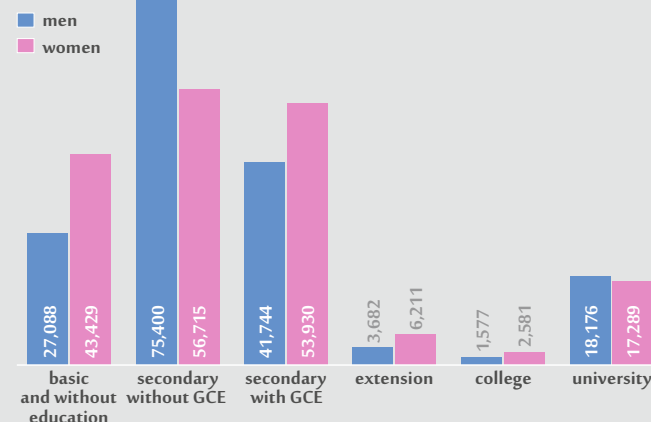
Children born out of wedlock

the share of children born out of wedlock in terms of live births, in %

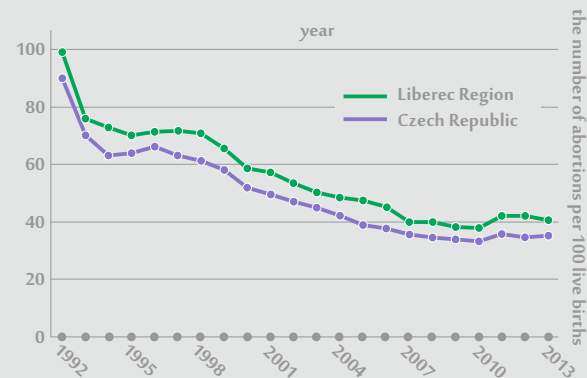


Education of the population

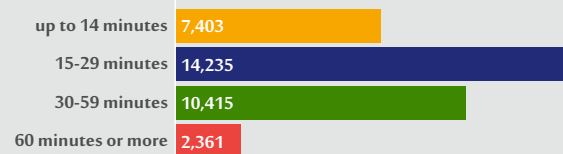

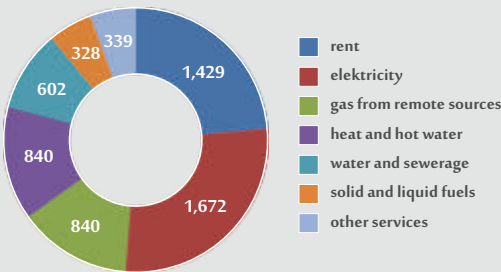

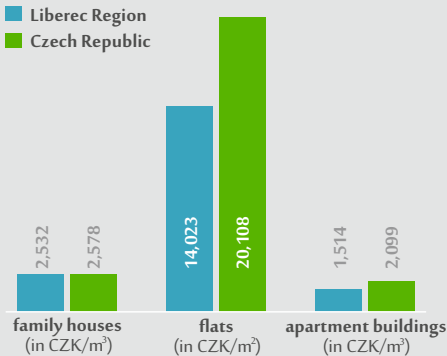
Cost of living

total monthly household bills in CZK, EU-SILC, 2013



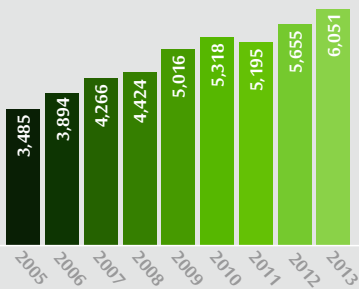
The average purchase price of real estate

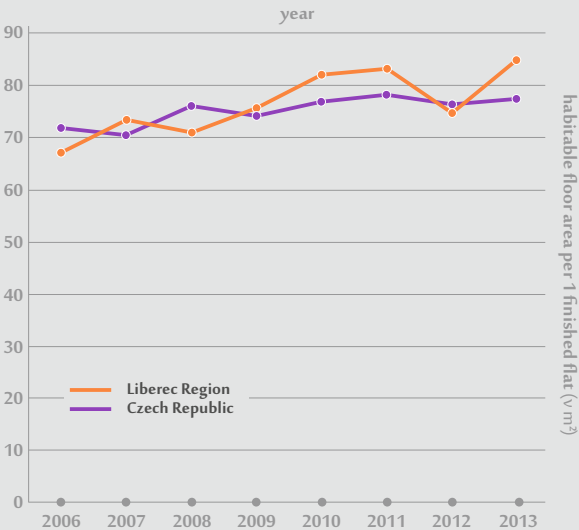


Housing costs

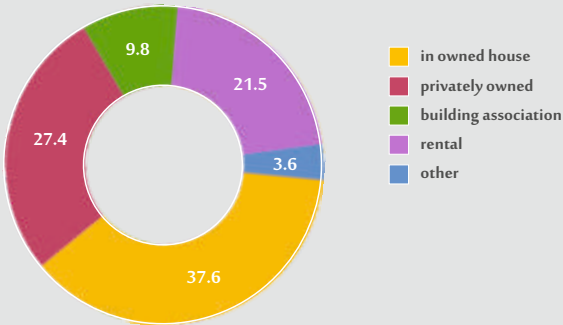

Types of flats by ownership

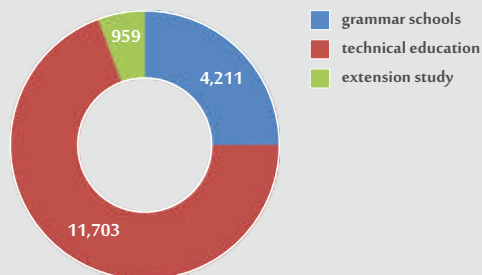

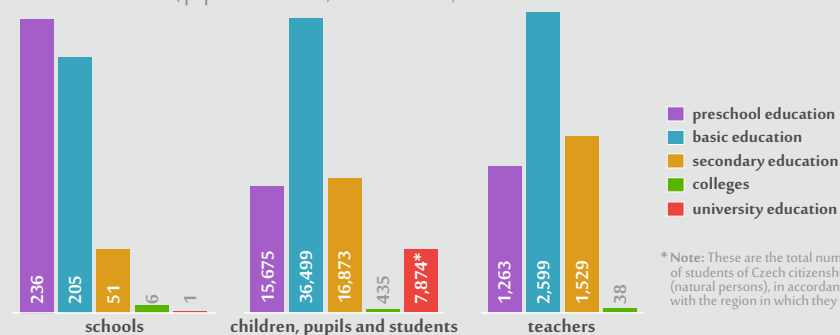

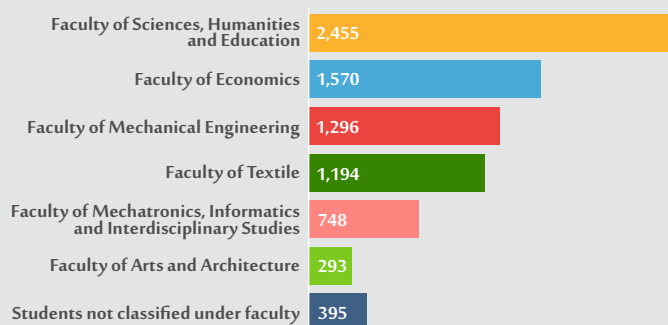
the number of schools, pupils and teachers, School Year 2013/2014

the number of students in individual faculties, 2013



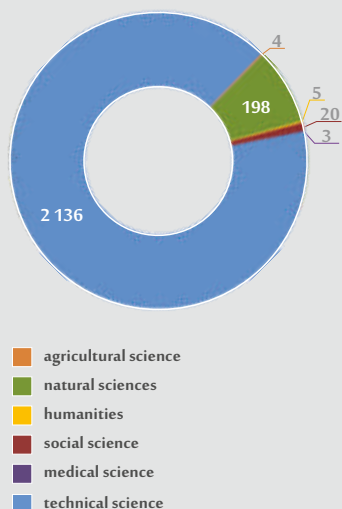

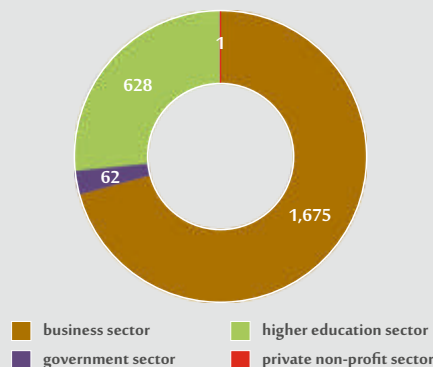
Expenditure on R & D by field of science

mil. CZK at current prices, 2013

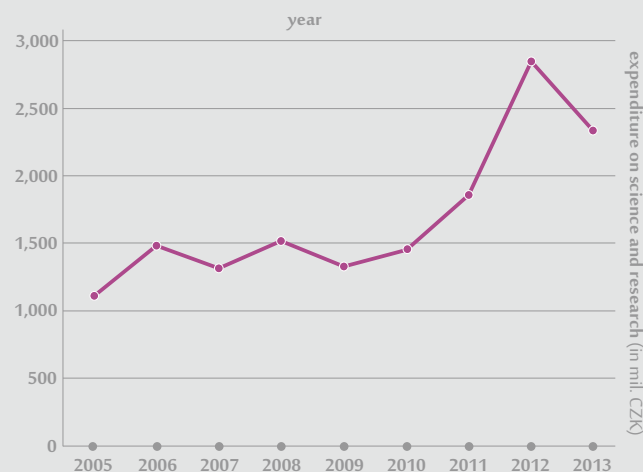


Expenditure on R & D by sector

mil. CZK at current prices, 2013



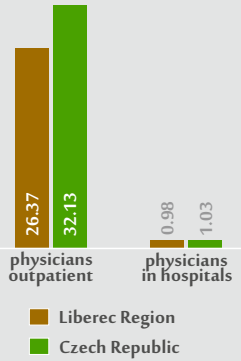

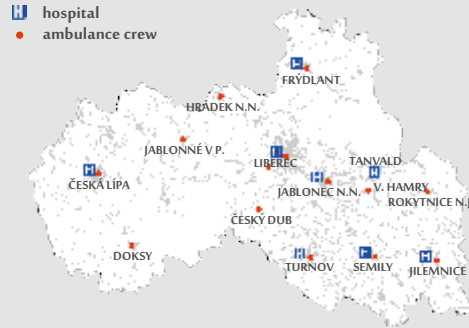
Number of physicians per 1,000 inhabitants

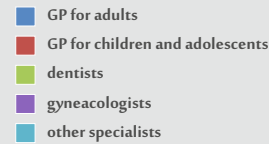

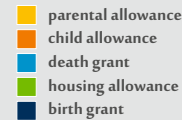

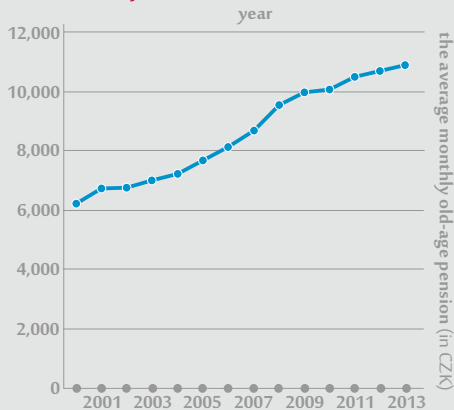

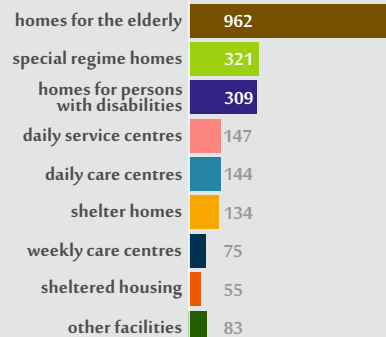

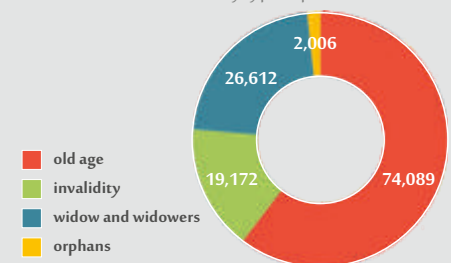

the number of places in facilities providing social services, 2013



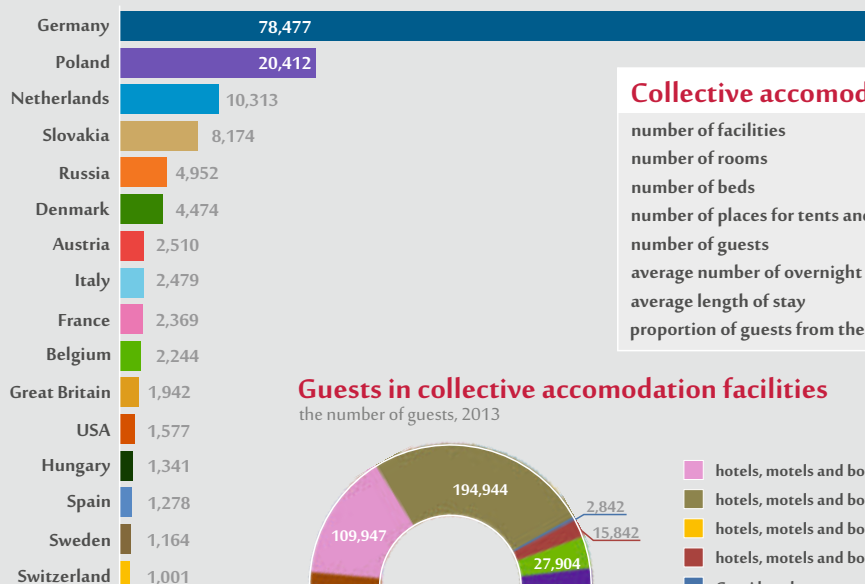
Pension beneficiaries

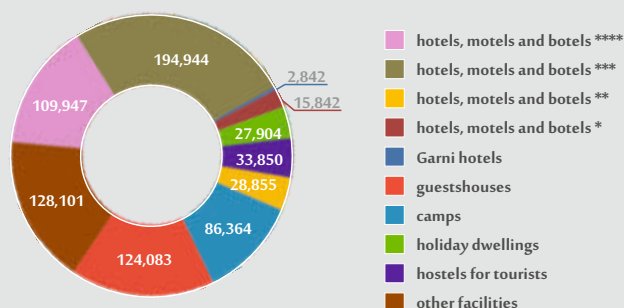

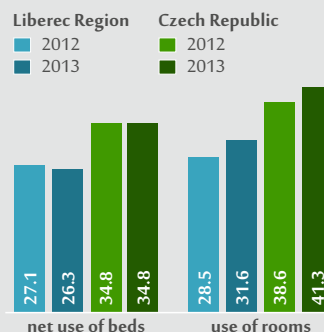

the number of guests, 2013

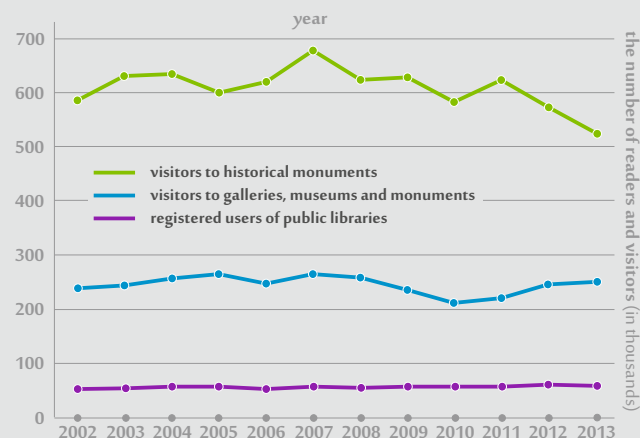


Use of beds and rooms

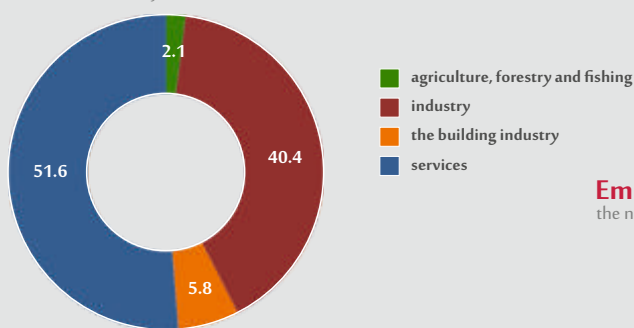

the share of industry in %, 2013



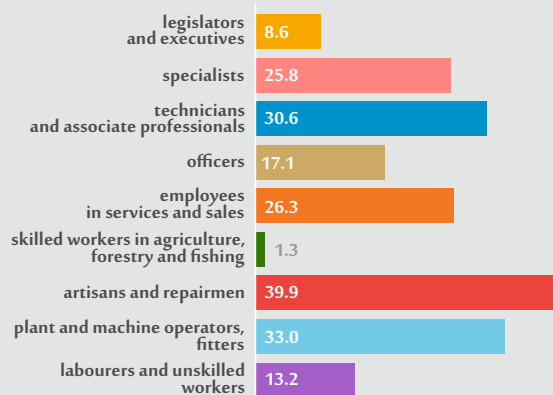

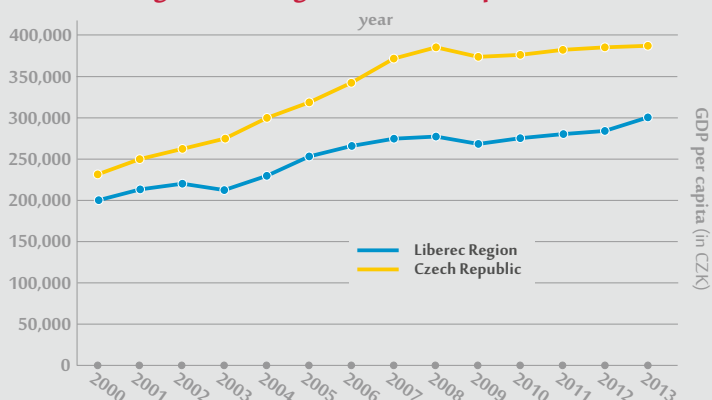

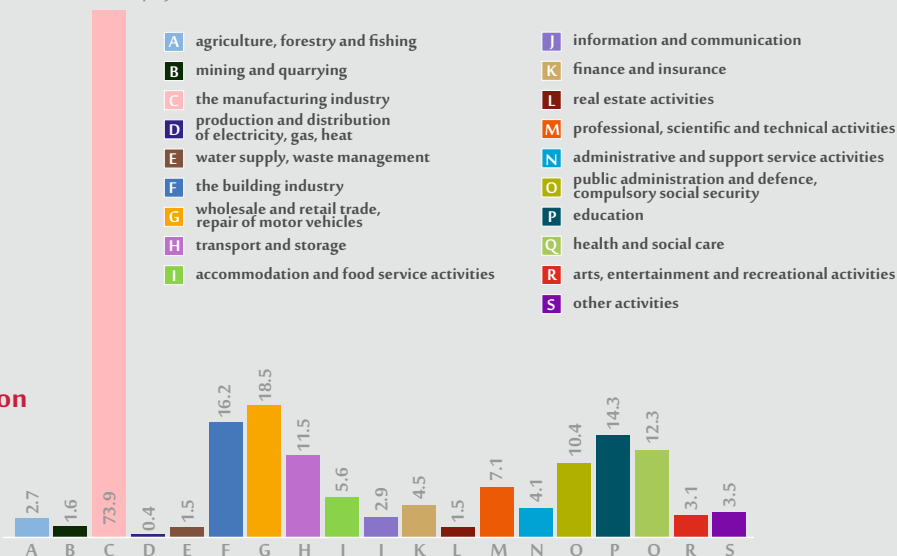


Trends in regard to the gross domestic product



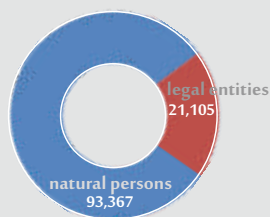
Employment by industry

the number of employees in thousands, 2013



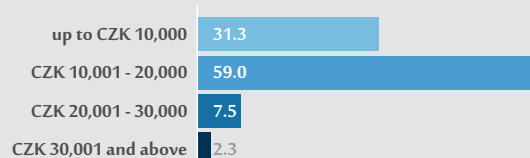
Businesses: by legal form

the proportion of households by monthly net money income per person, in %, EU-SILC, 2012

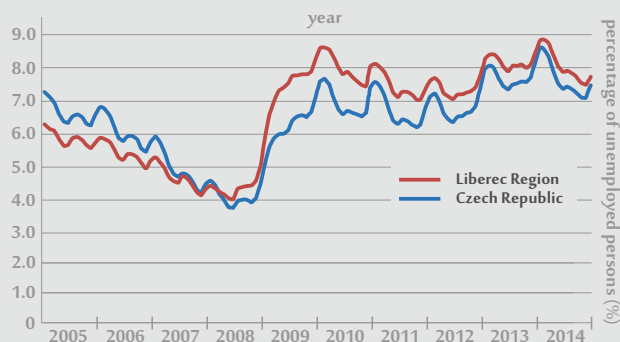

Trends in the percentage of unemployed persons



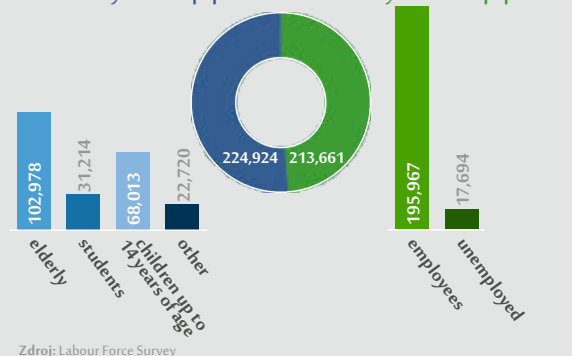

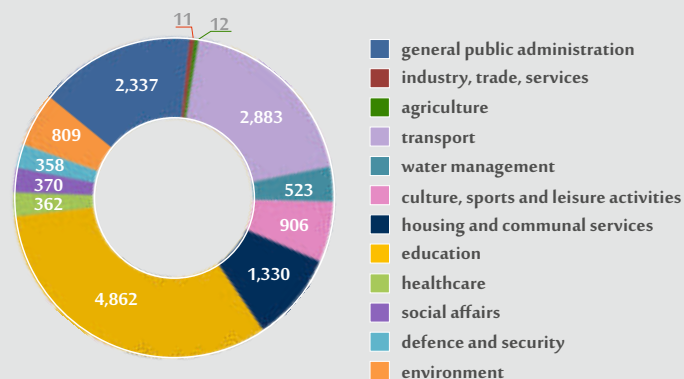


Unemployed job seekers by registration period

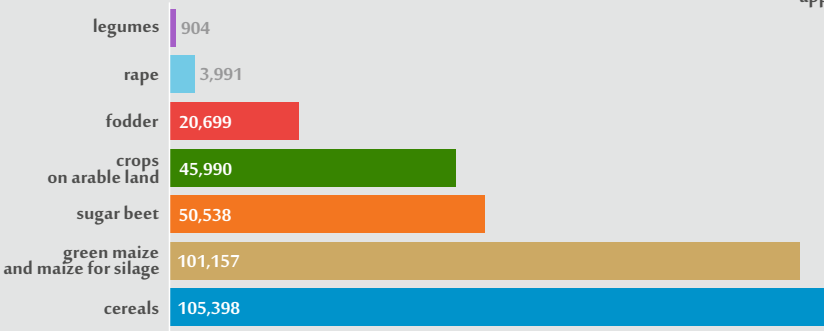

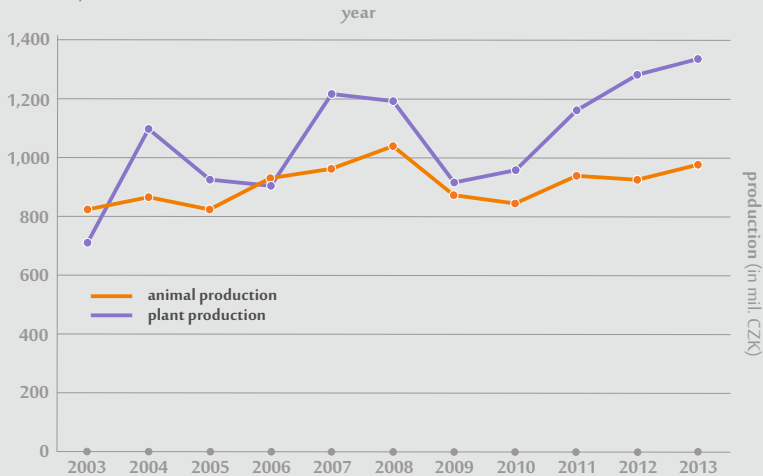

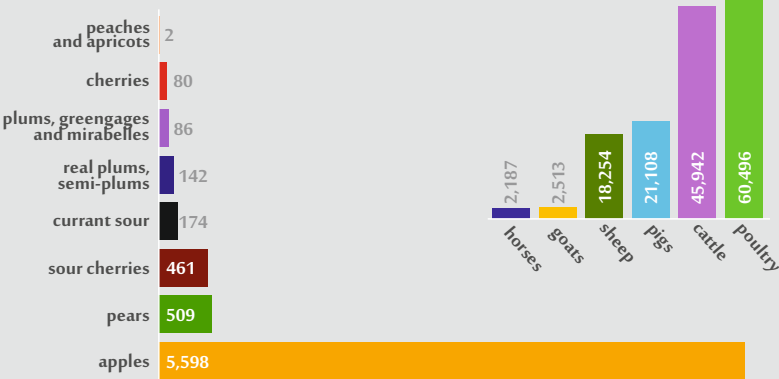
Harvest of selected crops
in t, 2013



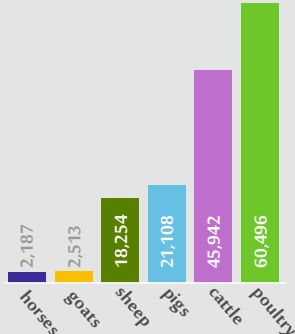
Trends in agricultural production
in current prices



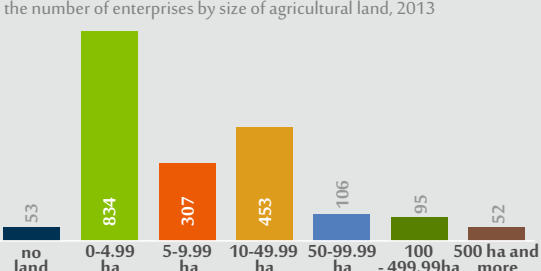
Fruit harvest

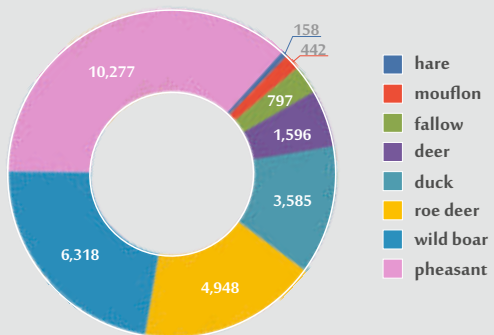


The structure of agricultural holdings

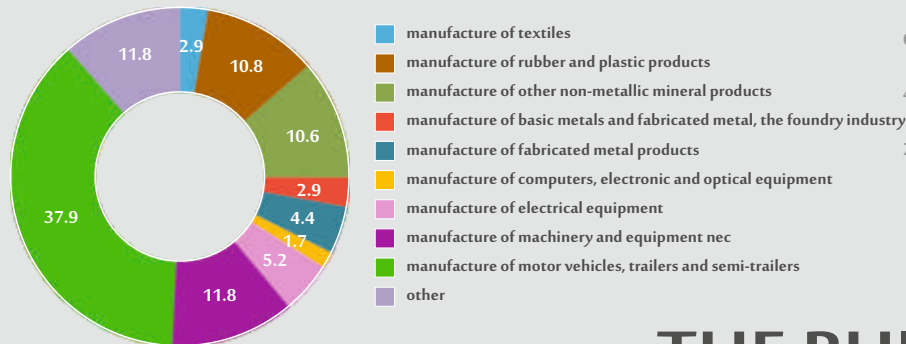

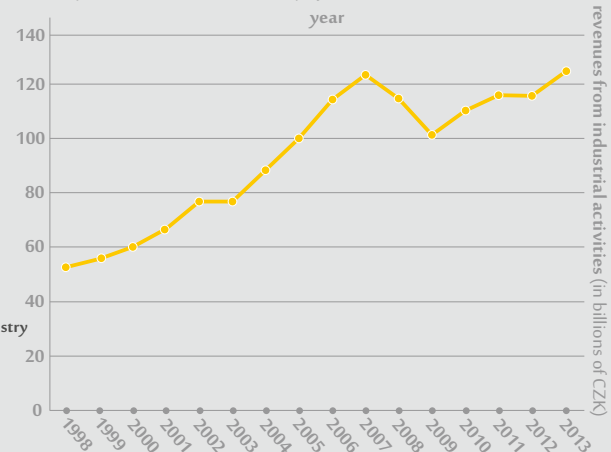
Employment in manufacturing industries

in %, in enterprises with more than 100 employees, 2013



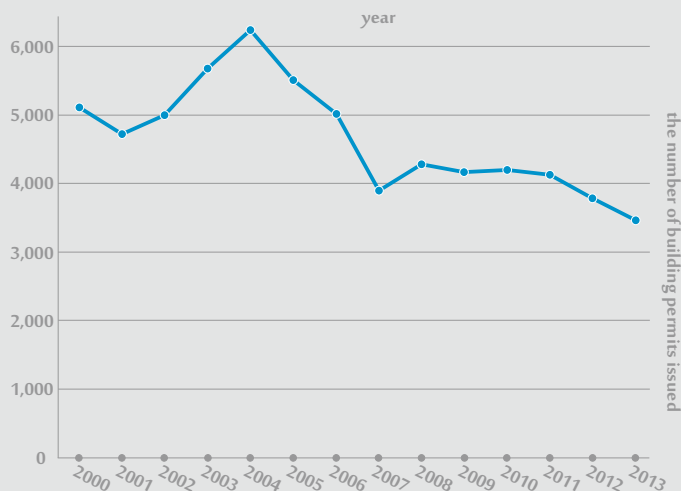
Trends in revenues from industrial activities

Trends in the number of buiding permits issued

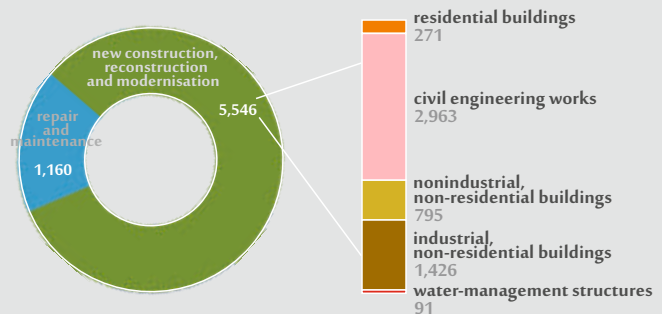

in enterprises with 20 or more employees, in mil. CZK, 2013

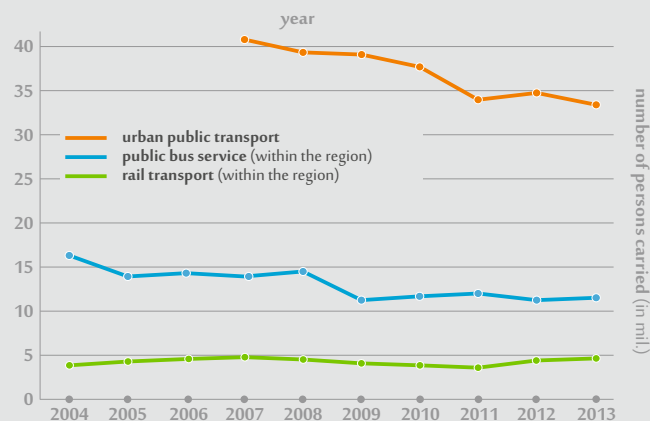

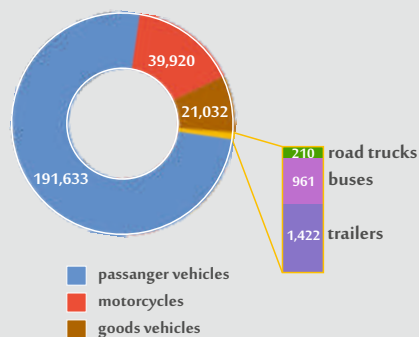

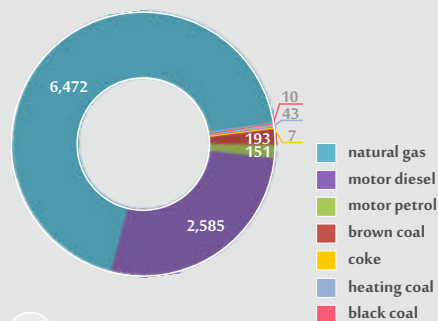

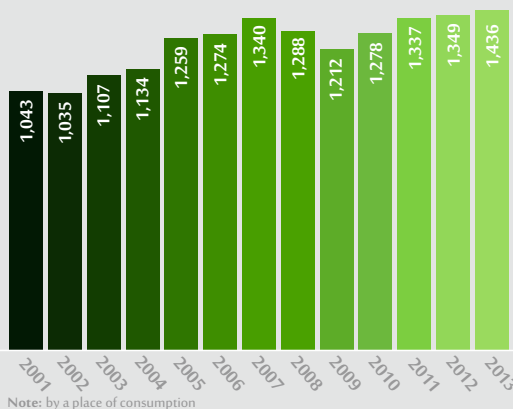
Fuel consumption

Trends in electricity consumption

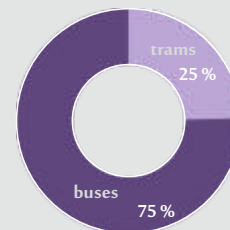

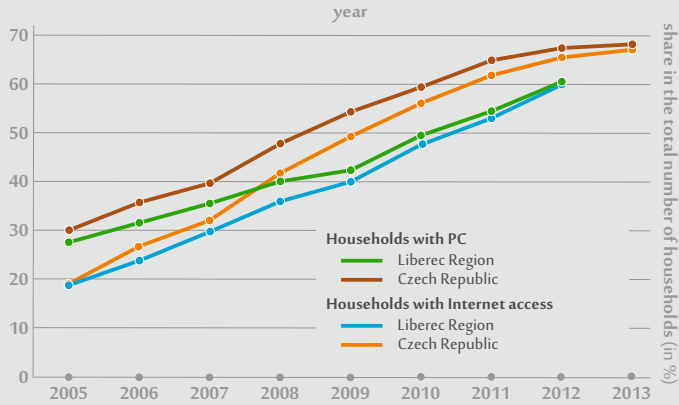

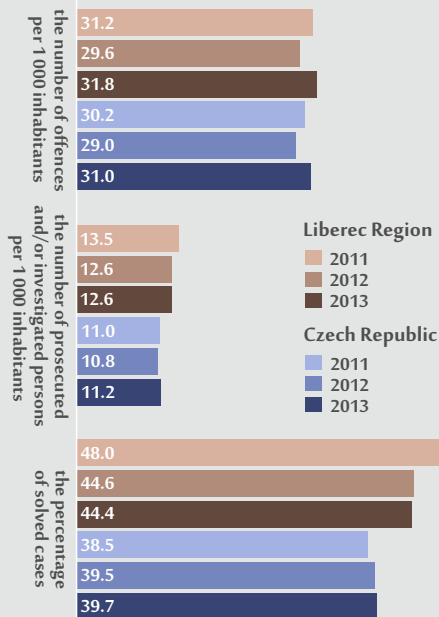

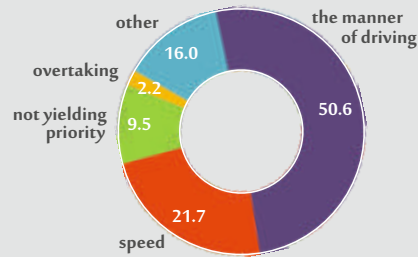

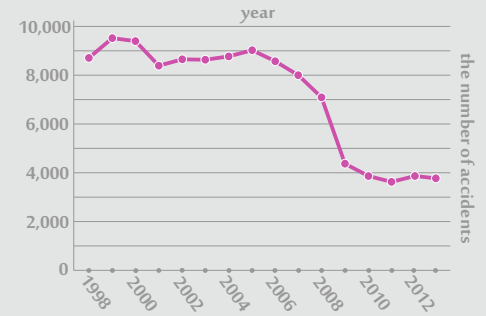


The main causes of traffic accidents

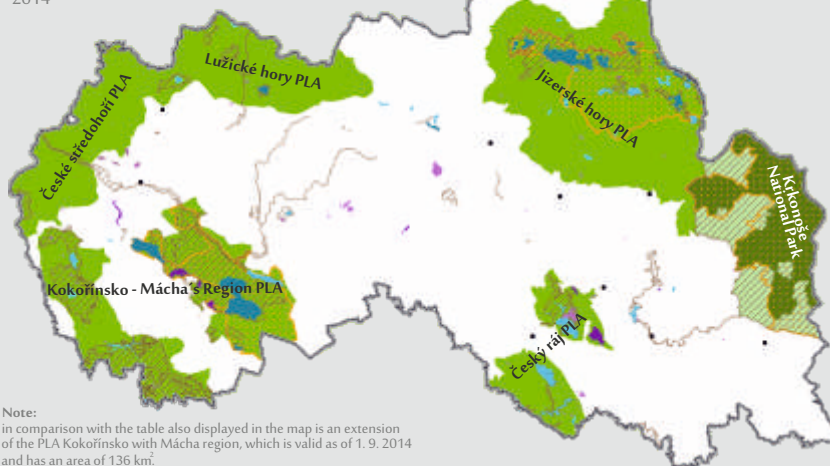

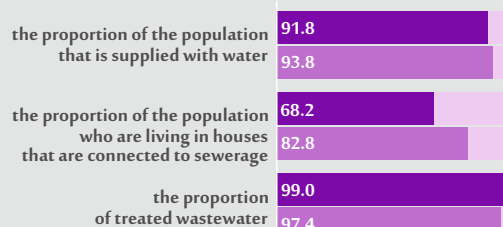

in %, 2013

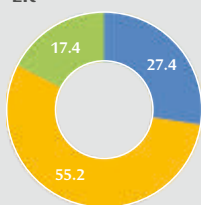

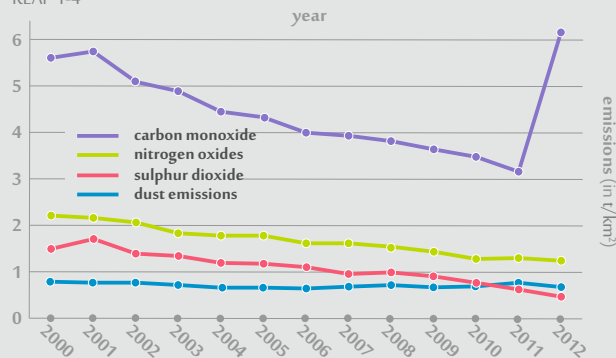

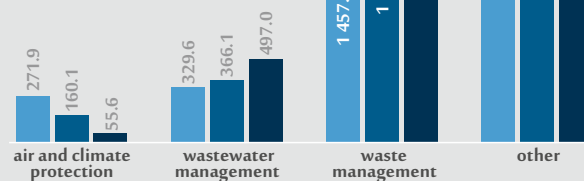

investment and non-investment expenses by the seat of an investor, in mil. CZK

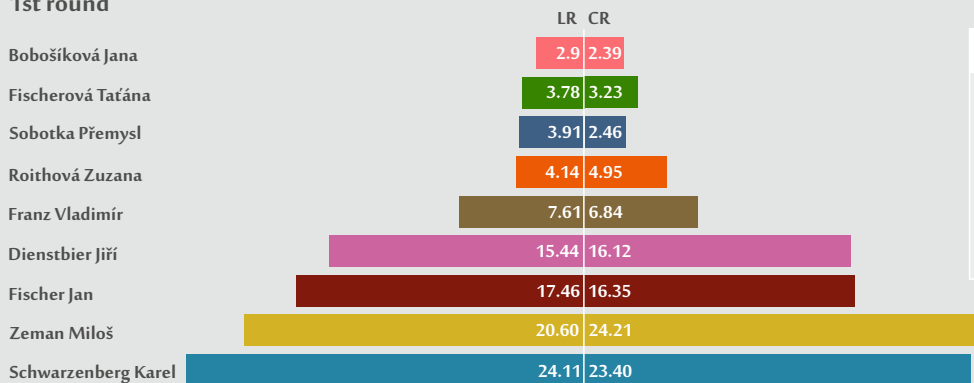

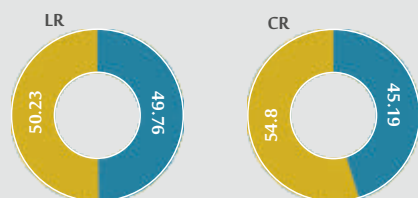

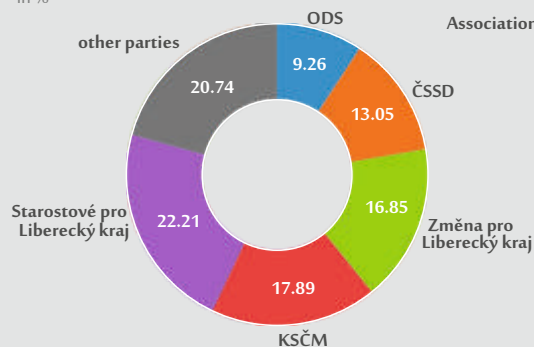

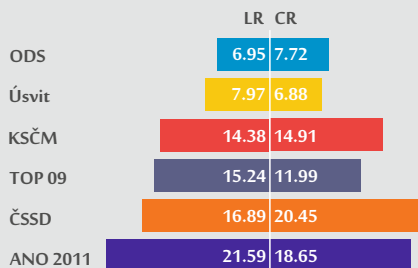
Regional elections - 2012

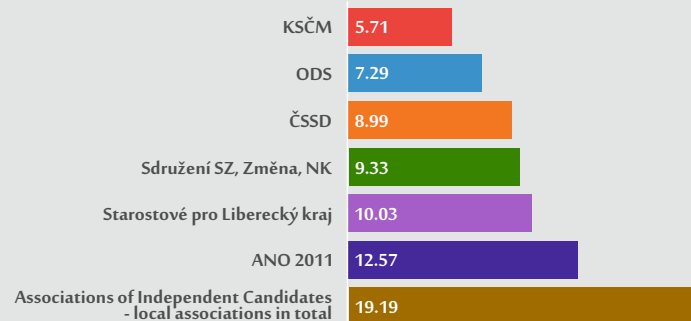

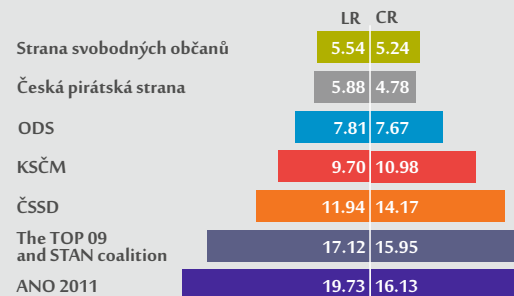
Municipal elections - 2014
